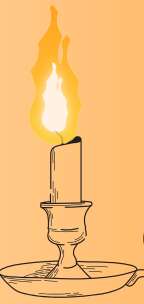




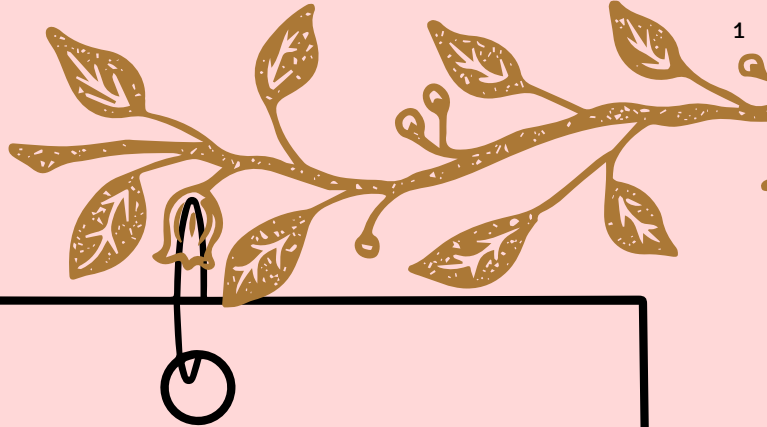

Pouring wisdom, beyond compare.

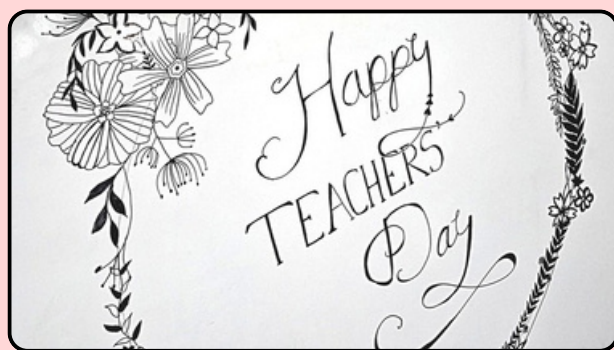
