2. Examination Reforms during the Period of Autonomy (500 Words):

- This HEI adopted Regulation for UG Programs (as approved by Utkal University) from 2018-19 Academic Session in the meeting of the Examination Committee of the college held on 27.09.2018. The Examination Committee in its meeting had decided to draft new Examination rules and regulations in consonance with the CBCS Course pattern from the session 2019-20 (2019 admission batch and onwards) and suitably modify the booklet on Examination Regulations of BJB Autonomous College. In the process of Examination reform, this college incorporated a Grading system, minimum Percentage of the pass mark taking together the results of Mid-Sem and End-Sem Examination results. The committee decided to treat “Examination Committee” as the “Committee for Credit transfer”. It was resolved to upload the result of the Final Degree students in the college website and preserve the UG answer scripts of the students for six months from the date of publication of the result for future responses.
- Reforms on malpractice and the award of punishment in such cases were stringently applied followed by the resolution taken in the meeting of the Examination Committee held on 15.02.2019. Odisha Common Syllabus for UG Courses was introduced by Odisha Higher Education Council to adopt it for 2019 admission batch of students. Examination Committee of the college held on 18.04.2019 after discussing the Model syllabus in detail, resolved to adopt it from 2019 admission batch. The pass percentage in each course was fixed at 40% by taking result of both the Mid-Sem and End-Sem examinations in total. It was unanimously resolved that all the 6th semester UG students across all regular programs must take project/ dissertation/ fieldwork under DSE-4.
- A meeting of the Examination sub-committee held on 27/05/2022 approved new courses; AECC-1, titled “Environmental Studies and Disaster Management” for semester-1 and AECC-2 titled “Ethics ad Values” for all semesters from 2021 Admission Batch. The facility of scribe was allowed to the students with 40% disability and additional time of 20 minutes was granted per hour of examination to the students with disability.

3. Number of Reports of the External Peer Team of the IQAC:

The Odisha State Higher Education Council (OSHEC) performed an Academic Performance Audit (APA) of Buxi Jagabandhu Bidyadhar Autonomous College, Bhubaneswar on 8th and 9th of March, 2022. As mandated by the Higher Education Department, Govt. of Odisha, four broad categories of institutional assessment were identified by OSHEC on (1) student related performance, (2) teacher centric performance, (3) infrastructure and (4) general activities that reflect academic growth, to assess the performance of the HEI for the session 2020-21. The audit team comprising of eminent academicians interacted with the Principal, IQAC, the Controller of Examinations, the Library-in-charge and the librarian and all the faculty members. The audit committee observed adequate number of the teaching faculties in significant number of departments and expressed overall satisfaction with the research publication activities of the faculty members despite the work pressure. Financial assistance given to poor and meritorious students and the activities of the counselling cell by certain departments, such as MSW department, was highly appreciated. The report took satisfactory note of the cut-off mark for students' admission which was amongst the highest in the state of Odisha. In its recommendations, the report identified some areas for institutional focus: such as upgradation of the college website, enforcement of plagiarism check, enhanced use of the e-resources etc. Similarly, the academic audit team of Utkal University visited this HEI on 31/07/2023 to undertake the academic audit for the purpose of renewal of the autonomous status of the college. To meet this objective, the audit team visited the different physical facilities of the college, interacted with the teaching and non-teaching staff members and students. The team observed that the college has a good academic ambience and imparts different UG programmes in Arts, Science and Commerce streams and PG programmes on regular and self-financing mode. The CBCS system had been adopted for the regular programmes since 2015-16. The committee also observed that the institution has adequate infrastructure for classrooms, laboratories, libraries, e-granthalaya, sports, hostels for boys and girls and also ancillary support facilities such as a branch of the SBI. The committee also expressed satisfaction that results were being published mostly on time and the performance of the students in examinations was appreciated by the team. The report also states that the institution is providing computer lab facilities to enhance the computer proficiency of the students and enhance their employability. The auditing team members also expressed satisfaction that regular meetings of the statutory and non-statutory bodies of the college were being organized. The team was also appreciative of the fact that

workshops, seminars, refresher courses, conferences and invited talks were being organized in the college.

The auditing committee suggested that there was scope for further improvement of the college regarding higher number of publications in indexed journals, holding of national and state level seminars in inter-disciplinary areas with funding from appropriate bodies, strengthening of the placement cell, enhanced accommodation capacity for the students and augmentation of the ICT infrastructure of the HEI.

B.J.B Autonomous College (hereafter, BJBAC) is one of the premier educational institutions of Odisha, came into existence in 1957 through the initiative of the Government of Odisha. It is named after Buxi Jagabandhu Bidyadhar Bhramarabara Ray Mahapatra, the famous Paika rebel of pre-independent India. It is an affiliated college of Utkal University and is functioning as an autonomous institution since 1999 following the conferment of autonomy by the UGC. The college was placed in Grade 'A' in 2004 after an assessment by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) and maintained an 'A' grade in the subsequent two cycles of re-accreditation. In the 2nd cycle, the college scored a 3.19 CGPA with an 'A' grade and the accreditation was valid up to Nov-2021. The Odisha State Higher Education Council, (hereafter, OSHEC) performed an Academic Performance Audit (APA) of the BJBAC over a period of two days starting on the 8th of March 2022. As mandated by the Higher Education Department, the Government of Odisha, OSHEC took this initiative to meet the objective of conducting an Academic Performance Audit (APA) of BJBAC for the session 2020-21.

The OSHEC reviewed the academic activities of various departments of BJBAC under four broad categories, (1) Student related performance, (2) Teacher – centric performance, (3) Infrastructure, and (4) general activities that reflect academic growth.

Detailed Report**Objectives**

The DHE, Government of Odisha introduced an Academic Performance Audit (APA) of all higher education institutions under its administrative control as a mandatory activity to be carried out regularly. OSHEC was assigned the responsibility to undertake the Academic Performance Audit (APA) of each higher education institution. The audit was aimed at the following:

1. To review the overall annual academic performance of the college
2. To review the performance of all regular programs offered by the college including the programs under PPP mode.
3. To review the performance of the college for NAAC reaccreditation and NIRF ranking and to appraise them of the critical areas of accreditation and ranking process.

Interaction with the Principal and Suggestions made


General Advisory to all Departments

The audit team identified the following areas wherein BJBAC needs to focus its attention.


1. All the departments should rephrase and revise their SWOC analysis keeping in mind the reality and vision and mission of the college. The IQAC unit of the college can guide them in this exercise.
2. All activities of the department should be published on the pages of the college website.
3. Guest teachers recruited for a period of 9 months continuously are to be considered in the category of 'regular teachers.'
4. Dropout analysis should be made carefully. Someone taking TC for employment should not be considered a dropout. Similarly, someone taking TC for his/her admission into some other programs in different HEIs should not be considered a dropout.
5. All academic documents such as project reports, dissertations, and theses should be subjected to a plagiarism check. This could be achieved by creating an Anti-Plagiarism Cell located in the main library of the college.
6. All teaching faculty should get themselves registered in the Publon platform and other similar academic platforms.
7. All teaching faculty should use e-Resources maximally provided to them through the EBSCO platform.
8. Mentor-Mentee meetings should be carried out regularly. It could be given a space in the timetable of each department. The proceedings of such meetings should be published on the web page of the college. It should not function as a grievance-redressal unit.
9. In addition to Academic Audits, IQAC should undertake Green Audits, Energy Audits, and Gender Audit regularly.
10. Adequate infrastructure should be provided to each department every year.

Recommendation

- Status of NAAC preparedness – Under process. The OSHEC team underscored the need for accreditation to ensure the renewal of the Autonomous status of the college and other financial assistance.
- Status of participation in NIRF – Not Participated, so far. The BJBAC should participate in the process of NIRF.
- The faculty of the BJBAC should publish their research article in SCOPUS and WoS journals, or UGC-CARE-listed journals.

Academic Audit Report of Buxi Jagabandhu Bidyadhar Autonomous College, Bhubaneswar

The Academic Audit Team of Utkal University visited the Buxi Jagabandhu Bidyadhar Autonomous College, Bhubaneswar on 31.07.2023 to undertake the academic audit for the purpose of renewal of the autonomous status of the college. On the basis of the visit to different physical facilities, interaction with the teaching and non-teaching members, students and verification of different documents submitted by the college, the visiting team noted the following observations.

XVIII. Observations of the Committee

1. The college is established by Government of Odisha in the year 1957 and situated at the heart of the capital city of Odisha spreading over 21.23 acres of land and has further scope for expansion. The college also houses one of the largest study centre of Indira Gandhi National Open University (IGNOU) and Odisha State Open University.
2. The college was accredited with 'A' grade by NAAC in 2004 and 2016 in two cycles and was valid up to 31 December 2022. The Third Cycle of NAAC Accreditation of the college is under process.
3. The college has a good academic ambience and imparts different UG programmes in Arts, Science and Commerce streams and PG programmes on regular and self-financing mode. The Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) curriculum has been adopted for the regular programmes since 2015-16.
4. The college is a multi-faculty co-education institution with nearly 6500 UG and PG students' enrolment in the streams of Arts, Science and Commerce along with the Self-Financing Courses being run in regular and PPP mode.
5. At present, there are 80 numbers of faculties in the college; 55(fifty five) of them are with Ph.Ds and 24(twenty four) of them are with M.Phil.
6. Adequate infrastructure for classrooms, laboratories, library, e-Granthanlaya, sports with well-maintained big playground, hostels for boys and girls, one branch of State Bank of India etc. are available in the college.
7. Conduct of examinations and publication of results are most mostly done on time. The results of the candidates in different examinations are satisfactory.
8. Computer lab facilities are provided to the students to make them computer literate and employable in the market.
9. Regular meetings of the Governing Body, Academic Council, Internal Quality Assurance Cell, Board of Studies and Teacher's Council have been organized.
10. Workshops, seminars, refresher courses, conferences, workshops, online ARPIT Courses of SWYAM and invited talks have been organized regularly.

XIX. Suggestions of the Committee

1. Research through sponsored project is lacking and the college needs to be given more attention. The faculty members should be encouraged to submit research proposal to different funding agencies for grants to undertake research.
2. Eligible faculty should be encouraged for research guidance leading to Ph.D.

3. Teachers in all subjects should be encouraged to publish more quality research articles in UGC care listed/Scopus journals.
4. More National and state-level seminars in interdisciplinary areas may be conducted. Departments should be encouraged to submit proposals in time to the funding agencies for financial support.
5. The placement cell should be strengthened and more soft skill development programmes/job-oriented short-term course should be undertaken for the students at regular intervals to make them employable.
6. Steps should be taken to fill up the vacant teaching in different departments and non-teaching posts at the earliest.
7. Hostel facility as per demand may be provided to the students.
8. More ICT facilities should be developed in the college for taking classes and conducting meeting/seminars online or blended mode.

XX. Recommendations of the Committee

The Committee recommends for renewal of autonomous status to Buxi Jagabandhu Bidyadhar Autonomous College, Bhubaneswar affiliated to Utkal University from the academic session 2023-24 to 2027-28.
